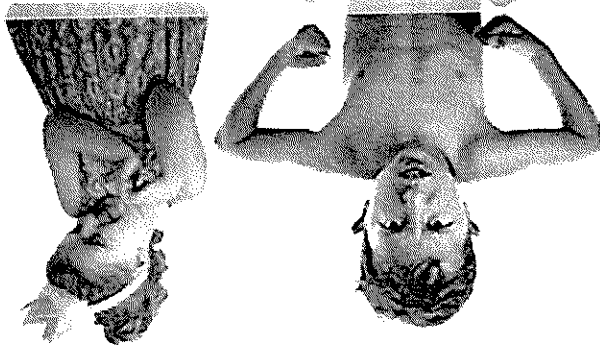

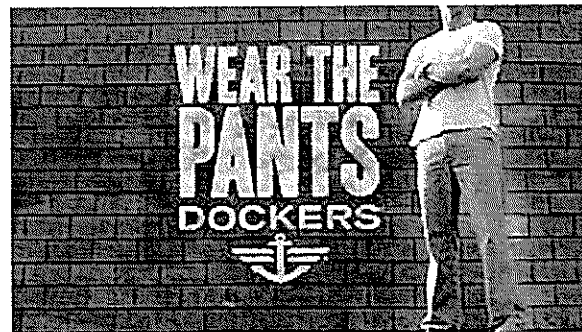
## Learning Objectives
