About the Conference

Many Americans are affected by family violence and abuse each year despite over 20 years of intervention work aimed at stopping it. Family violence cuts across the lifespan—from infancy, through adulthood, to old age. Family Violence is a leading cause of death, injury and psychological problems in our society.
