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About the Conference

Many Americans are affected by family violence and abuse each year despite over 20 years of intervention work aimed at stopping it. Family violence cuts across the lifespan—from infancy, through adulthood, to old age. Family Violence is a leading cause of death, injury and psychological problems in our society. Women, children, and poor families are disproportionately affected. The effects of interfamilial violence are also exacerbated by violence in the community and other stressors such as poverty.

The course will provide an overview of family violence across the lifespan. Also, the training program will assist facilitators in developing an understanding of the major issues related to intimate partner abuse, child abuse, elder abuse, teen dating violence, and intergenerational issues of violence in families.
