### DATING VIOLENCE TWELVE MONTH PROTECTIVE ORDER

A hearing was held on this matter on \_\_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_ for which the Respondent had notice as required by law and at which the Respondent appeared and/or was provided with the opportunity to be heard and the Petitioner requested that the Protective Order entered in this case be continued. Having heard the evidence presented, reviewed the petition and the entire record concerning this case and for good cause shown, the court FINDS that the parties are currently, or within the last six months were, in a dating relationship or that a current pregnancy has developed between the parties:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT/S – At least one of the following is found as initialed by the Judge:

a.	There is a committed romantic relationship between the parties that is not associated with mere friendship or ordinary business, social, or educational
	fraternization;
b.	Factors exist which corroborate the dating relationship;
c.	The parties developed interpersonal bonding above a mere casual
	fraternization;
d.	The length of the relationship between the parties is indicative of a dating
	relationship;
e.	The nature and frequency of the parties' interactions, including
	communications, indicate the parties intended to be in a dating relationship;
f.	The parties by statement or conduct demonstrated an affirmation of their
	relationship to others; or,
g.	Both parties have acknowledged the dating relationship;
b.	A current pregnancy has developed through the parties.

The Court relied on the following specific facts in finding the above

The Court further finds that probable cause exists that the following act(s) of Dating Violence has/have occurred in the past

 Simple battery (O.C.G.A. § 16-5-23)
 Battery (O.C.G.A. § 16-5-23.1)
 Simple assault (O.C.G.A. § 16-5-20)
 Stalking (O.C.G.A. § 16-5-90)
 Any felony

and may occur in the future.

#### THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

- 1. That these proceedings be filed in the office of the Clerk of this Court.
- 2. That this Order applies in every county throughout the state and it shall be the duty of every court and every law enforcement official to enforce and carry out the provisions of this Order pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 19-13A-4(e). Law enforcement may use their arrest powers pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 17-4-20 to enforce the terms of this Order.

4. The Respondent has violated the Dating Violence Act, O.C.G.A. § 19-13A-1 et [pco01] seq. by committing Dating Violence, and represents a credible threat to the physical safety of the petitioner. Respondent is hereby enjoined and restrained from doing or attempting to do, or threatening to do any act of injury, maltreating, molesting, following, harassing, harming, or abusing the Petitioner in any manner. Respondent is not to interfere with Petitioner's travel, transportation, or communication. Respondent shall not follow, place under surveillance, or contact the petitioner at any place of the Petitioner for the purpose of harassing and intimidating the Petitioner.

6. That this Court determined that it had jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter under the laws of the State of Georgia and the Court ordered that the Respondent be given reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard sufficient to protect the Respondent's due process rights. This Order shall be presumed valid and pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2265(a) shall be accorded **full faith and credit** by any other state or local jurisdiction and shall be enforced as ordered as if an Order of the enforcing state or jurisdiction.

7. [pco03]	Respondent is ordered to permit Petitioner to enter Respondent's residence to retrieve Petitioner's property and(sheriff or police department) is ordered to assist Petitioner in returning to Respondent's residence and retrieving Petitioner's property.
8. [pco04]	Respondent shall immediately surrender to law enforcement (sheriff or police department) all and any keys, garage door openers and other security devices to the Petitioner's residence and law enforcement shall ensure that these are given to the Petitioner.
9.	Petitioner's address is ordered to be kept confidential.
10.	Respondent is ordered to stay away from Petitioner's residence atand workplace atand school and any subsequent residence or workplace or school of Petitioner.
11. [pco 01, 04]	That Respondent is restrained enjoyed from approaching withinyards of Petitioner.
12.	Respondent is ordered not to have any contact direct or indirect, or through another person with Petitioner, by telephone, fax, email, electronic media, or any other means of communication except as specified in this Order.
13.	That Respondent, <b>only when accompanied by local law enforcement</b> shall be able to remove their clothing and personal items from the Petitioner's residence as follows:

14.	Respondent is ordered not to interfere with Petitioner including that

14. Respondent is ordered not to interfere with Petitioner including that Respondent may not sell, encumber, trade, damage, contract to sell, or otherwise dispose of or remove from the jurisdiction of this court any of the property of Petitioner.

That Petitioner shall be allowed to remove the following property from the 15. Respondent's residence for Petitioner's use: hereby ordered to assist the Petitioner during this removal. That Respondent shall be required to return the following property for 16. Petitioner's use: hereby ordered to assist the Petitioner during this removal. Respondent is ordered to undergo appropriate psychiatric, psychological, or 17. educational services (initial all that apply); Respondent is ordered to undergo evaluation for drug/alcohol abuse and to follow the recommended treatment. Respondent is ordered to undergo psychiatric/psychological/mental health evaluation and to follow the recommended treatment. It is further Ordered that the Respondent shall make arrangements to begin a Georgia Commission on Family Violence (GCFV) certified family violence intervention program (FVIP) within fourteen (14) days of the signing of this Order, or if appropriate within (14) days upon release from incarceration. A list of local certified agencies can be found at www.gcfv.ga.gov. Furthermore, Respondent shall appear before this court \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_ at \_\_\_.m. for a hearing on the status of their application, attendance and/or completion of the FVIP. At that hearing, Respondent is ordered to present to this court a written status report from the agency providing the certified FVIP. The status report shall detail Respondent's application, attendance and/or completion of or failure to apply, attend and/or complete the FVIP and shall be signed by an officer of the agency.

A person commits the offense of Aggravated Stalking when such person, in violation of a temporary or permanent protective Order prohibiting this behavior, follows, places under surveillance, or contacts another person on public or private property for the purpose of harassing and intimidating the other person. This activity can subject the Respondent to arrest and prosecution for felony Aggravated Stalking, which carries penalties of imprisonment for not less than 1 year nor more than 10 years and a fine of up to \$10,000.00.
