This role focuses on survivor identification, outreach, and community engagement, offering meaningful exposure to trauma-informed work, systems collaboration, and victim services.

## What You'll Do

- Assist with identifying and locating survivors through case documentation and interagency communication
- Support outreach efforts, including drafting materials and helping connect survivors to services
- Help gather and organize data related to murder-suicide incidents
- Contribute to outreach communications (social media content, flyers, presentations, PSA drafts)
- Attend community events, vigils, and outreach activities to support program visibility
- Observe SSMS presentations and, when appropriate, client interactions (education-level dependent)
- Brainstorm creative ways to reach survivors and raise community awareness
- (If skills align) Support survivor-centered storytelling projects, such as videos or digital content

- Compassionate, professional, and trauma-informed (or eager to learn)
- Strong organizational and communication skills
- Comfortable working with sensitive topics and confidential information
